

KITTENS: Kittens entered in the show must be at least 4 calendar months, but less than 8 months of age on the day of the show. Altered kittens are eligible for entry.

ANIMAL PLANET: A television crew will be filming at the show over the weekend, by entering the show you will be automatically agreeing to have yourselves and your cats filmed for the one hour documentary for Animal Planet.

SHOW THEME: Well with the TV Crew filming for Animal Planet we thought we might change this year but hey dust off your Easter Eggs because the theme is still 'Easter'. The best decorated pen as judged by an independent visitor will be awarded a prize and rosette.

TRANSPORT: The nearest airport that operates the PETS scheme is Heathrow. Regrettably, neither the hotel nor the club can provide transport. The nearest train stations are Milton Keynes or Bletchley. A map to the venue and the show hotel will be provided with entry confirmations.

EUROPE NORTH REGIONAL FUND: £1 per cat will be donated to the Europe North Regional Fund. Additional donations are gratefully accepted.

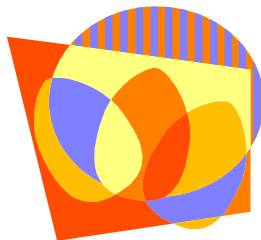

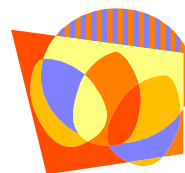
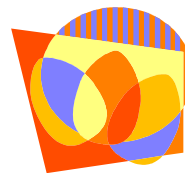

SHOW HOURS: Vetting in will be 7.30 a.m. – 8.30 a.m. on Saturday and 8.00 a.m. - 8.30 a.m. on Sunday. Judging will start promptly at 9:00 a.m. Advertised show hours are until 4.30 p.m. In consideration of our paying spectators, no cats may be removed from the show hall before the end of advertised show hours without the show manager's permission.

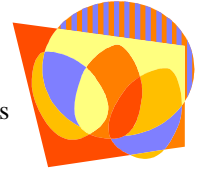
SHOW RULES: TICA Show Rules will be strictly enforced. Rosettes will be awarded in accordance with these rules. By entering all exhibitors agree to abide by the decisions of the Judges and Show Committee. Official Show Rules can be obtained for \$7.00 from TICA, P.O. Box 2684, Harlingen, TX 78551, USA or from www.tica.org

BENCHING AND SUPPLIES: The club will provide double pens (2ft x 4ft x 2ft) as standard. For every two cats entered by the same exhibitor, both will be put in the same pen (unless an extra pen is specifically booked). Vending from the

benching area is prohibited, there will be no cats/kittens for sale allowed in the show hall. Litter bins will also be provided but please bring your own litter trays, litter, water, cat food, dishes, and cage curtains (optional).

If you wish to bring your own Sturdi-Pen (instead of using the pens supplied), please indicate this on your entry form. Bench space will then be allocated for you.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: This is a vetted show. Cats showing signs of ear mites, fleas, fungus, or any other contagious illness will not be permitted in the show hall. All entries should have an up to date vaccination record for immunisation against Feline Enteritis and Cat Flu available for inspection during vetting-in. Any cat or kitten from a house or cattery where there has been fungus or any infectious or contagious illness within 21 days prior to the opening date of the show is ineligible for entry and/or exhibition. Any cat which is obviously pregnant or lactating will be disqualified. All claws (front and back) must be clipped prior to judging. Please note that any cat entered for both days only needs to be vetted-in once.



ENTRY FEES: 1 Day Rate CoonTICA members £37 for first cat, £34 for each additional cat. Non-members £39 for first cat, £36 for each additional cat.

2 Day Rate CoonTICA members £73 for first cat, £67 for each additional cat. Non-members £76 for first cat, £70 for each additional cat.

Early Bird offer - £1.50 per cat per day discount on entries and payments received by 17th February 2008. If any additional cat requires a solo pen, there will be a surcharge of £5 per day per pen. Late entries, at the Show Managers discretion, will attract a surcharge of £10 per cat per day. Substitution of a previously entered cat will incur an additional cost of £7.50 and will only be allowed before the 15th March 2008. Entry fees cover ring judging, catalogue and one entry pass per cat entered. Exhibition pens £25. Payment may be made by PayPal® to treasurer@coontica.org.uk Please add £1.50 per cat per day to cover PayPal charges.

EVERY 50TH CAT will get a FREE ENTRY.

REGISTRATION: With the exception of Korats and New Breeds, registration with TICA is not necessary to compete for a cat's first show, but is required for confirmation of titles and scoring for TICA Regional and International awards.

HOUSEHOLD PETS: HHPs over 8 months of age must be spayed or neutered. HHPs are ring judged and in order to claim titles or awards they must be registered with TICA. If you are unsure of your cat's colour or division, please send a colour photo of your cat along with your entry. Your photo will be returned.
